FRONT CORNERS (DETAIL #1)*

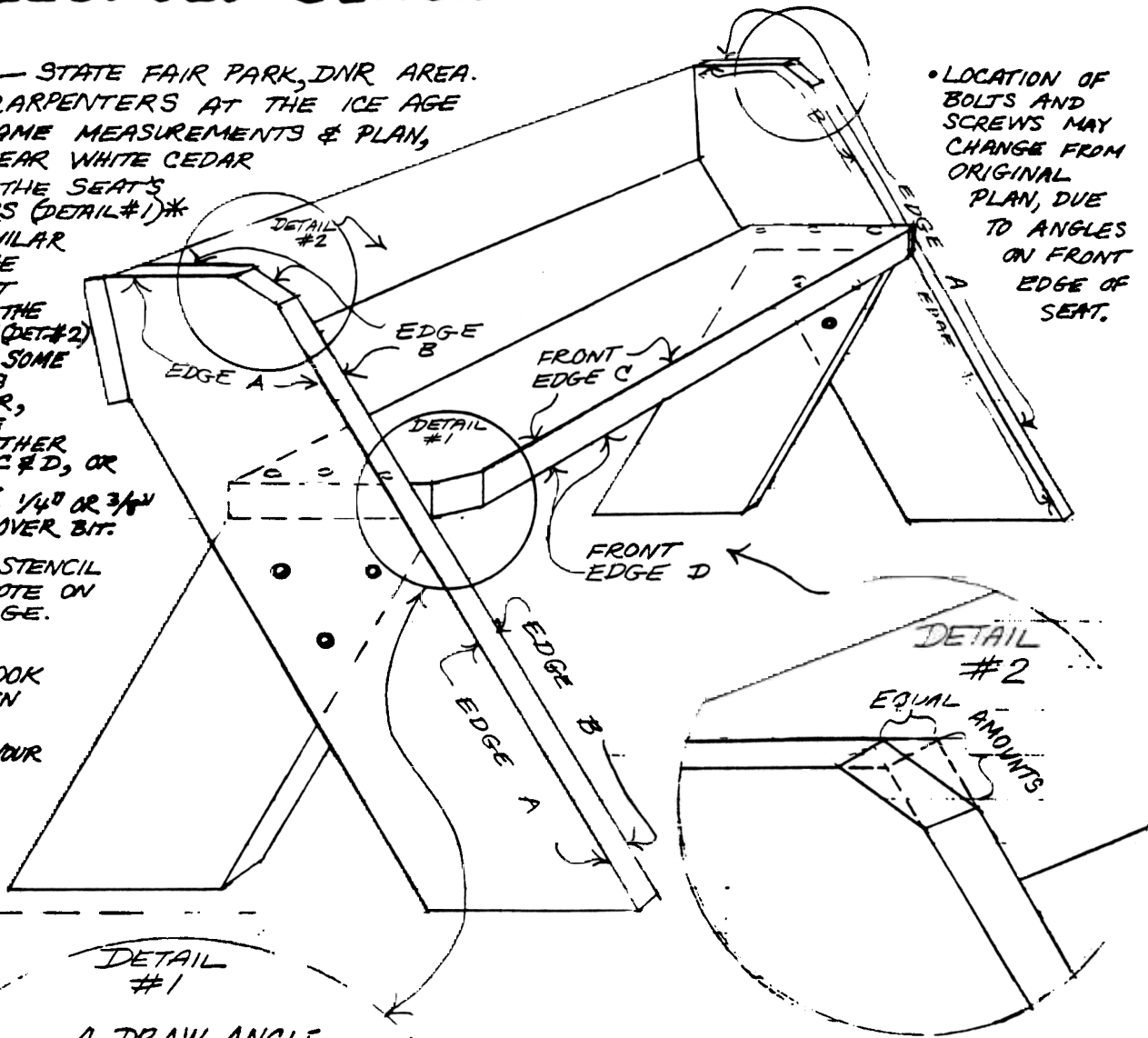
• DRAFT A SIMILAR
ANGLE ON THE
UPPER FRONT
CORNERS OF THE
LONGER LEGS (DETAIL #2)

• IF YOU WANT SOME
OF THE EDGES
ROUNDED OVER,
DECIDE BEFORE
ASSEMBLY. EITHER
EDGES A, B, C & D, OR
EDGE A & C.
ROUT WITH A $1/4"$ OR $3/8"$
ROUNDING-OVER BIT.

• WOODBURN, ROUT OR STENCIL
NAME, LOGO OR QUOTE ON
BACK, OR SEAT-EDGE.

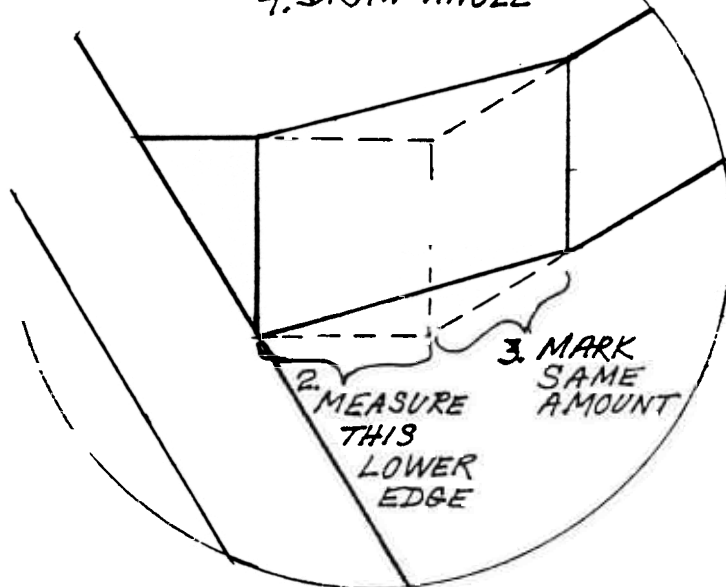
• WATCH FOR THAT LOOK

CHANGE FROM
ORIGINAL
PLAN, DUE
TO ANGLES
ON FRONT
EDGE OF
SEAT.

1992 NOTES: WILD ONES

- ATTACH BACKREST WITHOUT TRIMMING OFF THE $2\frac{1}{8}"$ X $6\frac{3}{4}"$ WEDGE — YOU MAY FIND THE ANGLE MORE COMFORTABLE. (WES WEINHOLD)
- BENCHES WILL BE STRONG UP TO 6 FT. LONG, AS LONG AS 2" LUMBER IS USED.
- UNFINISHED CEDAR BENCHES WEATHER TO A NICE, DARK COLOR IN 2 TO 3 YEARS. (KRISTIN SUMMERFIELD)
- HUNT FOR OLD LUMBER — YOU MAY BE ABLE TO MAKE ONE FROM RECYCLED MATERIALS & NEW HARDWARE (LUCY SCHUMANN)
- RESEARCH A WISCONSIN NATIVE PLANT COMMUNITY APPROPRIATE TO YOUR SITE (SEE THE VEGETATION OF WISCONSIN, BY JOHN CURTIS). SURROUND YOUR BENCH WITH WISCONSIN NATIVES.
- NICE AS A PAIR, OR GROUP IN A COUNCIL CIRCLE. (L.W. WAUKESHA FIELD STAFF)

• ONE MORE USE FOR A LEOPOLD BENCH: AS A VISUAL REMINDER, TO ASK YOURSELF, "WHAT HAVE I DONE TODAY, AS GOOD STEWARDSHIP OF THE LAND?"
